



New COVID-19 Guidance

As you will no doubt be aware, the government changed the national COVID guidance over half-term. Staff members now no longer need to wear masks, although you may still see some of us wearing them from time-to-time.

To continue to keep everyone safe, we feel it is important to follow the government advice for children and staff to test if they are symptomatic and continue to follow the guidance of isolating for five days and follow the guidance until they have received two negative tests on consecutive days.

If your child is still testing positive after ten days, they should return to school as, by this point, they will no longer be a risk to others.

By working together and following this advice this will help to keep the community safe and to keep children learning in school.

If your child is displaying symptoms at school, we will contact you as before to let you know and to allow testing to take place.


The festival will be taking place around Ockbrook and Borrowash on 2 and 3 June 2022.
