COVID-19 – A Transform Trust Update

Transform Trust issued a letter on Monday 29 November 2021 regarding new guidelines in response to the Omicron variant of Covid

Thank you to everyone who has already been involved when close contacts have needed to go home, your understanding and patience is very much appreciated.

If we are notified of a child positive case, we will ask for immediate child close contacts to isolate and secure a PCR test. A close contact is likely to be the children sat either side of the positive case, as well as siblings and close family members within the same household of the positive case. This will be for each school to judge.

If we are ever advised that a case of Omicron is in school, then the child close contacts will be asked to isolate for 10 days regardless of their PCR result. This is new national guidance

If the PCR test comes back negative we wish for that child to return to school. If any Covid variant but particularly Omicron gets into the classroom, we wish to have taken every possible step to prevent onward transmission without major disruption to school.
