Parking

Polite Reminder: Please continue to be respectful to our neighbours and surrounding homes to our school. Reports have been received that some drivers are mounting the pavement to park on the grass verge areas opposite our school during the drop off and pick up times.

As we are sure that you will have experienced, cars parked on the pavements/grass verges make it extremely difficult to see beyond to enable crossing the road safely and can also obstruct the pavement for those walking to and from school.

Damage to the grass verges caused by parked cars has also been reported, this damage has been exacerbated by the recent wet weather. A visit from the Road Safety Council Representative this week served as a reminder that the verges and pavements around our school are restricted parking zones, which is indicated by a yellow plaque.

Anyone contravening these restrictions may be subjected to a parking fine.
